DADE COUNTY HOUSE FIRE RULED ARSON

HUDGENS OFFERS REWARD

Atlanta - Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner Ralph Hudgens said a fire yesterday at a home in Dade County was intentionally set.

The fire, which occurred Tuesday afternoon around 12:30 p.m., at 3381 Hwy. 11 South in Rising Fawn, Georgia, originated in the kitchen area of the home. No one was home at the time of the fire and investigators estimate damages at \$35,000.

Commissioner Hudgens is asking anyone with information about this fire to call the Arson Hotline at **1-800-282-5804**. Rewards of up to \$10,000 are given for information leading to the arrest and conviction of an arsonist. Calls are taken 24 hours a day; callers can choose to remain anonymous.

Commissioner Hudgens' Fire Investigation Unit was assisted in the investigation by the Rising Fawn Fire Department.
